Open to any pony 4 years old or over. Riders any age. Maximum height of fences 60cm. This class is open to plaited and Heritage ponies.

Class 2 UNAFFILIATED WORKING SHOW HORSE

Mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, exceeding 148cms. Riders to have attained their 16th birthday by 1st January in the current year.

Class 3 THE B.S.P.S. NOVICE 153cm / INTERMEDIATE W.H.P.

Mare or gelding 4 years old or over, exceeding 143cms but not exceeding 158cms. Fences will be adjusted for each height section a) 153cm b) 158cm. Riders MUST jump in their correct height section and be the correct age for the height of the pony they ride. Riders may ride more than one pony providing they are of different height sections. Riders must declare if they are competing in the 153cm or Intermediate section.

Class 4 THE B.S.P.S. NOVICE 133cm / 143cm W.H.P.

Mare or gelding 4 years old or over, not exceeding 143cms. Fences will be adjusted for each height section a) 133cm b) 143cm. Riders MUST jump in their correct height section and be the correct age for the height of the pony they ride. Riders may ride more than one pony providing they are of different height sections.

Class 5 THE B.S.P.S. (RESTRICTED) OPEN 153cm / INTERMEDIATE W.H.P.

Mare or gelding 4 years old or over, exceeding 143cms but not exceeding 158cms. Fences will be adjusted for each height section a) 153cm b) 158cm. Riders MUST jump in their correct height section and be the correct age for the height of the pony they ride. Riders may ride more than one pony providing they are of different height sections. Riders must declare if they are competing in the 153cm or Intermediate section.

Class 6 THE B.S.P.S. (RESTRICTED) OPEN 133cm / 143cm W.H.P.

Mare or gelding 4 years old or over, not exceeding 143cms. Fences will be adjusted for each height section a) 133cm b) 143cm. Riders MUST jump in their correct height section and be the correct age for the height of the pony they ride. Riders may ride more than one pony providing they are of different height sections.

Mare or Gelding, 4 years old and over, not exceeding 122cms. Suitable to be ridden by a rider not to have attained not to have attained their 9th birthday before 1st. January in the current year. Maximum height and spread for fences 40cms. **Open to plaited or unplaited ponies**

Class 8 THE B.S.P.S. CRADLE STAKES (This class is not a qualifier)

Mare or gelding 4 years old or over, not exceeding 122cms. Riders not to have attained their 11th birthday before 1st January in the current year

Class 9 THE B.S.P.S. NOVICE NURSERY STAKES

Mare or gelding 4 years old or over, not exceeding 133cms. Riders not to have attained their 12th birthday before 1st January in the current year

Class 10 THE B.S.P.S. (RESTRICTED) OPEN NURSERY STAKES.

Mare or gelding 4 years old or over, not exceeding 133cms. Riders not to have attained their 12th birthday before 1st January in the current year

Fences will be adjusted for each height section a) not exc 122cm b) exc 122cm but not exc 133cm. Ponies must jump in their correct height section. Riders may ride more than one pony providing the animals are of a different height section.

Class 12 THE B.S.P.S. HERITAGE M&M NOVICE 143cm / exc 143cm WHP

Registered pure bred ponies 4 years old or over exceeding 133cms. Riders any age.

Fences will be adjusted for each height section a) exc 133cm but not exc 143cm b) exc 143cm. Ponies must jump in their correct height section. Riders may ride more than one pony providing the animals are of a different height section.

Class 13 THE B.S.P.S. HERITAGE M&M OPEN 122cm / 133cm WHP

Registered pure bred ponies 4 years old or over exceeding 122cms but not exceeding 133cms. Riders any age.

Fences will be adjusted for each height section a) not exc 122cm b) exc 122cm but not exc 133cm. Ponies must jump in their correct height section. Riders may ride more than one pony providing the animals are of a different height section.

Class 14 THE B.S.P.S. HERITAGE M&M OPEN 143cm / exc 143cm WHP

Registered pure bred ponies 4 years old or over not exceeding 143cms. Riders any age.

Fences will be adjusted for each height section a) exc 133cm but not exc 143cm b) exc 143cm. Ponies must jump in their correct height section. Riders may ride more than one pony providing the animals are of a different height section.

Heritage WHP Championship. Open to 1st and 2nd prize winners from classes 11 - 14

Class 15 UNAFFILIATED RIDDEN PONY

Mare or Gelding, 4 years or over not exceeding 153cms. Not to have been placed 1st more than twice in affiliated showing classes. Rider any age

Class 16 THE B.S.P.S. NOVICE INTERMEDIATE SHOW RIDING TYPE/SHOW HUNTER

Mare or gelding 4 years old or over, exceeding 146cms but not exceeding 158cms. Riders not to have attained their 25th birthday before 1st January in the current year.

Class 17 THE B.S.P.S. (RESTRICTED) OPEN INTERMEDIATE SHOW RIDING TYPE/SHOW HUNTER

Mare or gelding 4 years old or over, exceeding 146cms but not exceeding 158cms. Riders not to have attained their 25th birthday before 1st January in the current year

Intermediate Championship. Open to 1st and 2nd prize winners from classes 16 - 17

Class 18 THE B.S.P.S. (RESTRICTED) OPEN LEADING REIN SHOW PONY (This class is not a qualifier)

Mare or gelding 4 years old or over, not exceeding 122cms. Riders not to have attained their 8th birthday before 1st January in the current year

Class 19 UNAFFILIATED TINY TOTS FIRST RIDDEN

Mare or gelding 4 years old or over, not exceeding 122cms. Open to SP, SHP, M&M, not required to be plaited. Riders not to have attained their 9th birthday before 1st January in the current year. This class will be judged on the suitability of the pony to introduce a child to the show ring.

Class 20 THE B.S.P.S. (RESTRICTED) OPEN LEAD REIN OF HUNTER TYPE (This class is not a qualifier)

Mare or gelding 4 years old or over, not exceeding 122cms. Riders not to have attained their 9th birthday before 1st January in the current year

Class 21 BSPS OPEN FIRST PONY OF SHOW PONY OR SHOW HUNTER PONY TYPE

Mare or gelding 4 years old or over, not exceeding 122cms Suitable to be ridden by a rider not to have attained their 10th birthday before 1st January in the current year. Snaffle bridles only. No cantering is allowed except for individual performances, ponies must leave the ring at the walk or trot.

Mini Championship. Open to 1st and 2nd prize winners from classes 18 - 21

Class 22 THE BSPS (RESTRICTED) OPEN PART BRED NOT EXCEEDING 148cms

Stallion, mare or gelding 4 years old or over not exceeding 148cms. Riders any age, with the exception of those riding stallions whom must have attained their 14th birthday before 1st January in the current year. Open to part bred Arab, Welsh, Dartmoor, Connemara and New Forest ponies.

Class 23 THE BSPS (RESTRICTED) OPEN PART BRED EXCEEDING 148cms

Stallion, mare or gelding 4 years old or over exceeding 148cms but not exceeding 158cms. Riders any age, with the exception of those riding stallions whom must have attained their 14th birthday before 1st January in the current year. Open to part bred Arab, and Welsh ponies ONLY.

Part Bred Championship. Open to 1st and 2nd prize winners from classes 22 - 23

Class 24 THE B.S.P.S. NOVICE PONY OF SHOW HUNTER TYPE NOT EXCEEDING 133cms

Mare or gelding 4 years old or over, not exceeding 133cms. Riders must be the correct age for the height of the pony they ride.

Class 25 THE B.S.P.S. NOVICE PONY OF SHOW HUNTER TYPE NOT EXCEEDING 153cms

Mare or gelding 4 years old or over exceeding 133cms but not exceeding 153cms. Riders must be the correct age for the height of the pony they ride.

Class 26 THE B.S.P.S (RESTRICTED) OPEN MIXED HEIGHT SHOW HUNTER PONY

Mare or gelding 4 years or over, not exceeding 153cms. Riders must be the correct age for the height of the pony they ride

Show Hunter Pony Championship. Open to 1st and 2nd prize winners from classes 24 – 26

Class 27 THE B.S.P.S. MIXED HEIGHT NOVICE SHOW PONY

Mare or gelding 4 years old or over not exceeding 148cms. Riders must be the correct age for the height of the pony they ride

Class 28 THE B.S.P.S. (RESTRICTED) OPEN MIXED HEIGHT SHOW PONY

Mare or gelding 4 years or over, not exceeding 148cms. Riders must be the correct age for the height of the pony they ride

Class 29 THE B.S.P.S. HERITAGE M&M NOVICE LEAD REIN

Mare or gelding 4 years old or over not exceeding 122cms. Riders not to have attained their 9th birthday before 1st January in the current year.

Class 30 THE B.S.P.S. HERITAGE M&M NOVICE FIRST RIDDEN

Mare or gelding 4 years old or over not exceeding 128cms. Riders not to have attained their 12th birthday before 1st January in the current year. Any suitable bridles permitted.

Class 31 THE B.S.P.S. HERITAGE M&M (RESTRICTED) OPEN LEAD REIN

Mare or gelding 4 years old or over not exceeding 122cms. Riders not to have attained their 9th birthday before 1st January in the current year.

Class 32 THE B.S.P.S. HERITAGE M&M (RESTRICTED) OPEN FIRST RIDDEN

Mare or gelding 4 years old or over not exceeding 128cms. Riders not to have attained their 12th birthday before 1st January in the current year. Any suitable bridles permitted.

Heritage Mini Championship. Open to 1st and 2nd prize winners from classes 29 - 32

Class 33 NOVICE RIDDEN COLOURED

Mare, gelding or stallion, 4 years or over, non-native/native/traditional/cob/show cobs. Not to have been placed 1st more than twice in affiliated showing classes. No Lead Rein exhibits.

Class 34 CHAPS (UK) RESTRICTED COLOURED NON-NATIVE HORSE/PONY

Mare, gelding or stallion, 4 years or over. To be shown plaited and trimmed. Exhibits will not be ridden at this show. No Lead Rein exhibits.

Class 35 CHAPS (UK) RESTRICTED COLOURED NATIVE/TRADITIONAL/COB/SHOW COB TYPE HORSE/PONY

Mare, gelding or stallion, 4 years or over. To be shown either with full mane, tail and feather or hogged and trimmed as appropriate. Exhibits will not be ridden at this show. No Lead Rein exhibits.

Coloured Championship. Open to 1st and 2nd prize winners from classes 33 - 35

Class 36 NOVICE HORSE

Mare or Gelding, 4 years or over exceeding 148cms. Not to have been placed 1st more than twice in affiliated showing classes.

Class 37 RIDDEN HUNTER

Mare or Gelding, 4 years or over exceeding 148cms. Small Hunter not to exceed 158cms

Class 38 RIDDEN COB/MAXI COB

Mare or Gelding, 4 years or over exceeding 148cms

Class 39 RIDDEN HACK/RIDING HORSE

Mare or Gelding, 4 years or over exceeding 148cms

Class 40 THE B.S.P.S. HERITAGE M&M NOVICE RIDDEN SMALL BREEDS

Registered pure bred Welsh Section A & B, Dartmoor, Exmoor and Shetland ponies 4 years old or over. Riders any age

Class 41 THE B.S.P.S. HERITAGE M&M NOVICE RIDDEN LARGE BREEDS

Registered pure bred Welsh Section C & D, New Forest, Connemara, Fell, Highland and Dale ponies 4 years old or over. Riders any age.

Class 42 THE B.S.P.S. HERITAGE M&M (RESTRICTED) OPEN RIDDEN SMALL BREEDS

Registered pure bred Welsh Section A & B, Dartmoor, Exmoor and Shetland ponies 4 years old or over. Riders any age

Class 43 THE B.S.P.S. HERITAGE M&M (RESTRICTED) OPEN RIDDEN LARGE BREEDS

Registered pure bred Welsh Section C & D, New Forest, Connemara, Fell, Highland and Dale ponies 4 years old or over. Riders any age.

Heritage M&M Championship. Open to 1st and 2nd prize winners from classes 40 - 43

Class 44 SSADL MIXED AGE IN HAND

Open to in hand HOME PRODUCED horses and ponies 15 years and over. Each section will be marked separately and one animal from each section shall qualify for 2nd round qualifiers (Pre-Senior 15-18, Senior 19-23, Senior Plus 24+)

Class 45 SSADL MIXED AGE RIDDEN

Open to ridden HOME PRODUCED horses and ponies 15 years and over. Each section will be marked separately and one animal from each section shall qualify for 2nd round qualifiers (Pre-Senior 15-18, Senior 19-23, Senior Plus 24+)

SSADL Champ – 1st and 2nd of each age group from classes 44 - 45

RULES AND REGULATIONS

This show is affiliated to the British Show Pony Society (BSPS) and all persons entering, competing, showing or otherwise taking part in BSPS classes, whether or not members, are subject to the Constitution & Rules of the BSPS, including disciplinary procedures and shall be deemed to have consented to the jurisdiction of the BSPS. All rules as per the 2019 BSPS Rule and Show Handbook.

This show is a qualifying show for the BSPS Winter Championships 2019 to be held at Arena UK

Novice classes - the 1st, 2nd and 3rd prize winners will qualify. In the case of a mixed height novice class, 1st, 2nd, 3rd and 4th will qualify.

Restricted classes – Animals eligible for restricted classes must not have been placed 1st-8th at the RIHS, HOYS or Olympia in the relevant class in 2017, 2018 or 2019 (with the exception of pretty polly or young rider classes) which they are entering. The three highest placed Restricted animals will qualify. In the case of a mixed height open class, the four highest placed Restricted animals will qualify. Qualification cards will be presented in the ring to those qualifying. Cards to be sent with entries for the Winter Championships.

Riders of Restricted animals must wear an armband.

BSPS Classic Security (UK) Ltd Challenge – This Show is a qualifier for the B.S.P.S. Classic Security (UK) Ltd Challenge. Animals competing in the following Open classes will qualify:- Open Lead Rein, First Ridden, Lead Rein Hunter Type, Show Pony, SHP, Cradle and Nursery Stakes, WHP, Intermediate SH, SRT and WH and Open Heritage Lead Rein, First Ridden, Ridden and WHP classes.

BSPS Premier League – This show is a qualifier for the BSPS Premier League. Animals competing in the following classes will qualify: Open Lead Rein, First Ridden, Lead Rein Hunter Type, Show Pony, Show Hunter Pony, Intermediate SRT/SHT, Cradle Stakes, Nursery Stakes, Working Hunter Pony, Heritage Lead Rein, First Ridden, Ridden and Working Hunter Pony.

Animals must be registered before the date of the show at which they qualify for the BSPS Championships and must be ridden by BSPS members, except in the case of exhibitors who have never been members before, who are allowed 7 days in which to become members and register their ponies.

CHAPS (UK) Winter Restricted Classes – Exhibits not to have qualified for HOYS in the current and previous year in which the Finals will be held (e.g. for 2019 Finals the horse or pony must not have qualified for HOYS in either 2017 or 2018). The 2 highest placed from each height/type category may qualify.

Both the owner or rider of any exhibit need not be fully paid up members of CHAPS (UK) at the time of competition, nor must the animal be registered, but to validate qualification both membership and registration must be in place with CHAPS (UK) at the time of entering the relevant years finals and both sections of the qualification card must be returned as per the instructions on the card.

All stallions must be graded with CHAPS in order to compete in these classes.

The Committee does not accept liability for any accident, injury, damage or illness to horses, ponies, owners, riders, spectators or any other person or their property. It is a condition of entry that each exhibitor or competitor shall indemnify the organisers and hold them harmless against such matters aforesaid.

Directions to College EC, Keysoe

From East

A428 to St Neots, carry on past St Neots on A428, you will go under road & railway bridges, past a crane storage on left, then over a roundabout by Tesco. At next roundabout turn Right on to B1428 (Great North Road), over at least 3 mini roundabouts then at mini roundabout immediately after pedestrian lights turn left onto Bushmead Road. Follow that for about 3.5 miles, then straight over crossroads, and after 1.5 miles you come to a T junction, turn Right. Church Road in Keysoe is 2 miles on the left

From South M1

J13 A421, and stay on that road for 13 miles until the last Bedford exit (A428 Bedford & Great Barford). First exit on roundabout at top of slip, then at next Roundabout (by "Go Outdoors" store on Right) Turn Right, carry straight over roundabouts for 2 miles, then at Roundabout for Kimbolton Road (it has trees in the middle and a pub called The Pheasant on other side) Turn Right, past Golf Course and carry on for 8 miles to Keysoe. Church Road is one mile into the village on the left.

From the South A1

After Tempsford bridge, take the A421 for Bedford at the Black Cat Roundabout (sign Milton Keynes A421) after 4 miles take the Bedford A428 exit (signed Bedford A428 Great Barford) Right at roundabout at top of slip, over other slip roundabout then at next Roundabout (by "Go Outdoors" store on Right) Turn Right, carry straight over roundabouts for 2 miles, then at Roundabout for Kimbolton Road (it has trees in the middle and a pub called The Pheasant on other side) Turn Right, past Golf Course and carry on for 8 miles to Keysoe. Church Road is one mile into the village on the left.

From the North M1 J15

A45 past Northampton & Wellingborough to Rushden, at big roundabout take third exit for A6 south. At next roundabout take first exit for Kimbolton (this route is subject to an 18 ton limit) take this road for 10 miles, then on the far side of Kimbolton turn right onto the B660 on the far side of Kimbolton turn right onto the B660 (sign Bedford Pertenhall B660). Church Road in Keysoe is 5 miles on the right

From the North M6

A14 Past Kettering carry on to J16 (Old Weston Kimbolton B660) take the exit slip and at T turn left for Kimbolton. Follow B660 to end T junction, then turn left through Kimbolton (18 ton limit) on the far side of Kimbolton turn right onto the B660 (sign Bedford Pertenhall B660). Church Road in Keysoe is 5 miles on the right

From the North A1

Past Huntingdon to Buckden roundabout, turn right for Grafham (Kimbolton B661) Follow that road to T junction at end in Great Staughton (by Snooty Tavern) Turn right for Kimbolton, as you approach Kimbolton turn left on B660 on the far side of Kimbolton turn right onto the B660 (sign Bedford Pertenhall B660). Church Road in Keysoe is 5 miles on the right
